NAME

lnxx — return name of current terminal

SYNOPSIS

jsr pc,lnff
(filedes in r0)

jsr pc,lnxx
(standard input assumed)

lnxx(filedes)

DESCRIPTION

Lnxx extracts the last character (or 2 characters for double character identifiers) of the terminal name which is the standard input or is specified by the argument *filedes* (file descriptor of a file). If the terminal name is */dev/l_nk*, *k* is returned; if */dev/l_nkk*, *kk* is returned.

If the file description does not correspond to a terminal, **"xx"** is returned.
